

Farm Labour for Fruit Tree Sector

Seeking farm labour worker in the Fruit Tree Sector beginning approximately mid-April. No education and experience are required, but it would be an asset to have some knowledge of planting, training fruit trees, pruning, cultivating, irrigating and harvesting of tree fruit. Additional farm related tasks such as the operation of farm machinery related to crop care, the ability to graft apple rootstock is a necessity, be aware of disease and health problems in crops would also be an asset. Tasks are all outdoors, repetitive, physically demanding, in a fast paced environment, with the requirement of good hand/eye coordination, attention to detail and the ability to distinguish between colours. Ladder work is required. Hourly rates are minimum wage at \$11.00/hr, 40 – 48 hours per week. Public transportation is available, a valid driver's licence would be an asset.
