The NS Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) Program is an educational program for farmers, delivered by the NS Federation of Agriculture. The EFP program helps farmers identify and assess environmental risk on their property. It enables farmers to incorporate environmental considerations into their everyday business decisions. The Program is presently seeking a summer student.

Duties:

Under the direction of the EFP Team, The EFP Summer Student will be primarily responsible for entering environmental based data into a database system, aid in the development of farm-level resource materials (fact sheets, newsletters and website content) and performing general office administration duties.

Qualifications:

Requirements of this position include:

- Currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution and returning to school in the fall.
- Strong communication and organizational skills, including attention to detail.
- Familiarity with the NS Agriculture Industry (past experience working on a farm or with farmers would be considered an asset)
- Demonstrated ability to work independently, and have demonstrated team-work skills.
- Self-motivated and demonstrate an interest in agriculture.
- The ability to take direction and work on task
- Fluency in English
- Some travel within the province may be required.

Note: This is a 14-week position from the date of hire.
