Accounting for 3.9 percent of all farm operating revenues in the province, Antigonish is the 6th largest county in Nova Scotia out of 18, in terms of agricultural operating revenues.

DID YOU KNOW?

Antigonish County accounted for **11%** of the provinces Dairy Cattle and Milk farms.

DID YOU KNOW?

Cattle farming in Antigonish decreased **9%** from the previous census and comprised **8%** of the NS sector total. The most significant shift in Cattle farming was a **24%** decrease in the number of Dairy farms, while the number of Beef farms increased by **3%**.

FUN FACT:

Antigonish county was home to **1** Mushroom farm in 2021, equal to **20%** of the provincial total.

36% DECLINE IN THE NUMBER OF NURSERY AND TREE FARMS. FROM 28 TO 18. 37% DECLINE IN THE NUMBER OF HAY FARMS. FROM 27 TO 17.

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2021, the leading agriculture industry in terms of number of farms was Cattle Ranching and Farming (Beef & Dairy) at 728 farms, with the number of farms increasing by 53 from 2016.


As of the past Statistics Canada Census of Agriculture, Antigonish County made up 5 percent of all farms in Nova Scotia.

Paid labour by type




The number of full-time workers decreased 14% from 57 to 49 workers between 2016-2021.

The number of seasonal or temporary workers decreased 65% from 292 to 102 between 2016-2021.

The number of paid family members decreased by 31% from 81 to 56, while the number of part-time workers also decreased 22% from 55 to 43.

Farms by size - Acres




The most significant shift was in the number of farms sized 400-559 acres from 32 to 14 farms.

Other notable changes include a reduction of 17 farms sized 180-239 acres, and 5 fewer farms sized 240-399 acres.

The only increase was in the number of farms sized 1,120-1,599 acres, from 1 to 2 farms.

Farms by revenue - 2021



The largest concentration of farms by a revenue category was in the \$1-\$9,999, and \$10,000-\$24,999 accounting for 24% respectively.

There were 7 farms earning revenues over \$1,000,000.

30% of farms were earning revenues above \$100,000.
