**Operating** Revenues

\$3,442,313

Accounting for 0.5 percent of all farm operating revenues in the province, Guysborough was the 14th largest county in Nova Scotia out of 18, in terms of agricultural operating revenues.

DID YOU KNOW?

Guysborough County accounted for **7%** of the provinces Nursery and tree farms.

SID YOU KNOW?

Cattle farming in Guysborough increased **29%** from the previous census and comprised **1%** of the NS sector total. The most significant shift in Cattle farming was an **40%** increase in the number of Beef farms, while the number of Dairy farms stayed the same.

### **FUN FACT:**

Guysborough county was home to **18** different Greenhouse, nursery, and floriculture farms in 2021, equal to **6%** of the provincial total.



### Paid labour by worker type




The number of full-time workers decreased by 55% between 2016-2021.

The number of seasonal or temporary workers decreased by 75% between 2016-2021.

Both the number of part-time workers and paid family members decreased by 27%, and 65% respectively between 2016-2021.

### Farms by size - Acres




The most significant shift was in the number of farms sized 10-69 acres from 29 to 17.

Other notable changes include a reduction of 11 farms sized 240-399 acres and 8 fewer farms sized 400-559 acres.

The only category that did not experience a decline was the number of farms sized 1,120-1,599 acres remaining unchanged at 1 farm.

### Farms by revenue - 2021



The largest concentration of farms by a revenue category was 18 farms in the \$1 to \$9,999, accounting for 38% of the total share of farms.

There was 1 farm earning revenues over \$1,000,000.
