Accounting for 0.5 percent of all farm operating revenues in the province, Yarmouth was the 13th largest county in Nova Scotia out of 18, in terms of agricultural operating revenues.

Yarmouth County accounted for **5%** of the province's Vegetable and melon farms.

OID YOU KNOW?

Cattle farming in Yarmouth increased 23% from the previous census and comprised 2% of the NS industry total. The most significant shift in Cattle farming was an 27% increase in the number of Beef farms, while the number of Dairy farms stayed the same.

FUN FACT:

Yarmouth county was home to **5** Sheep and goat farms in 2021, equal to **7%** of the provincial total.






The number of full-time workers decreased by 23% between 2016-2021.

The number of seasonal or temporary workers decreased by 67% between 2016-2021.

The number of part-time workers decreased by 33% between 2016 and 2021.

Farms by size - Acres



The most significant shift was in the number of farms sized 10-69 acres from 21 to 16.

Other notable changes include a reduction of 3 farms sized 240-399 acres and 3 fewer farms sized 70-129 acres.

The most significant increase was in the number of farms sized under 10 acres, from 10 to 13 farms.

Farms by revenue - 2021



The largest concentration of farms by a revenue category was in the \$1 to \$9,999, accounting for 35% of the total share of farms.

There were 0 farms earning revenues above \$1,000,000.
