

# 8 Wastes Found On Farm

## TRANSPORTATION

Moving items or information. For example, moving feed to and from different locations on site.



## INVENTORY

Product or information that the customer hasn't received yet and so it remains sitting or in storage.



## MOTION

Excessive movement within a workspace such as walking or driving back and forth while fixing a broken fence.



## WAITING

Waiting for supplies to arrive, equipment to be repaired or information to be shared.



## OVERPROCESSING

Doing more work than necessary or duplicating information in more than one place.



## OVERPRODUCTION

Doing work before it is needed or having supply come in faster than demand.



## DEFECTS

Mistakes and errors that need to be reworked or equipment that breaks down due to a lack of proactive maintenance.



## SKILLS

Not using workers to their fullest abilities. New hires are put to work without proper training.
